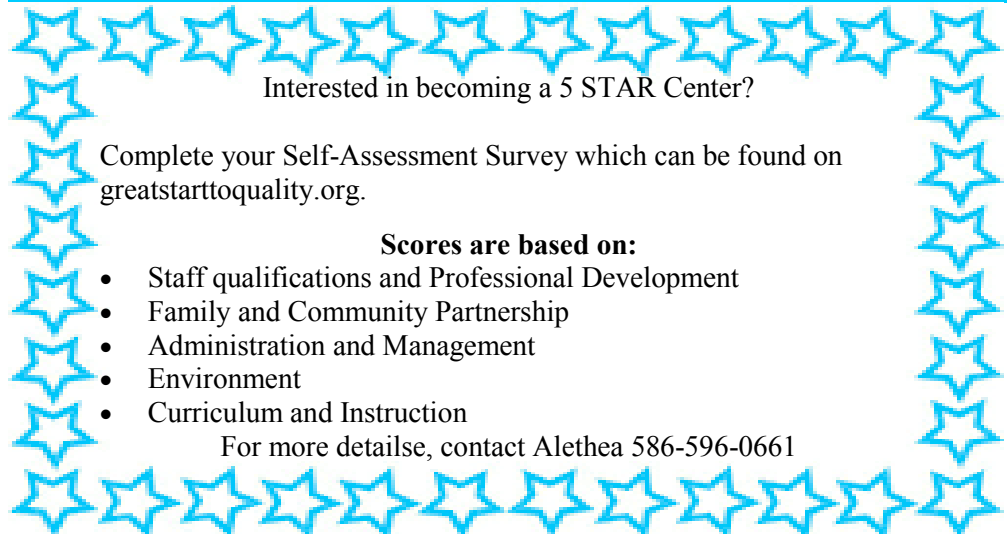
### **Great Start To Quality Orientation**

This training includes: child development, setting up shared expectations for children in your care, health, safety and nutrition, basic first aid and CPR certification. **You must register for this class by going on line to [greatstarttoquality.org](http://greatstarttoquality.org) or by calling your local Early Learning Community Agency. There is a \$10 fee for the orientation that is non-refundable.**
