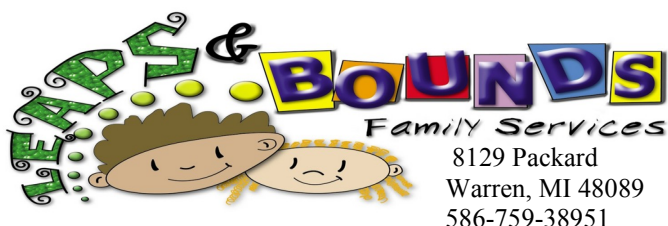
Planning a Safe and Healthy Environment

CSEFEL is a national resource center funded by the Office of Head Start and Child Care Bureau for disseminating research and evidence-based practices to early childhood programs across the country.

- 1.1: Relationships as the Foundation**– In this training, participants will describe the importance of building relationships with children, families, and colleagues. Participants will also understand the relationship between children's social/emotional development and challenging behaviors.
 - 1.2: High Quality, Supportive Environments**– In this training, participants will describe the relationship between environmental variables, children's challenging behaviors, and social/emotional development. Schedules, routines, and transitions will also be addressed.
 - 1.3: Preschool Responsive Routines**– In this training, participants will learn strategies that can be used to build positive relationships with children and their families. Participants will also learn how to plan large and small group activities that promote engagement.
