There is a \$10 fee for the orientation that is non-refundable.**

Have fun while focusing on the skills that are necessary to help prepare your young child for kindergarten. This program is for children from **birth to five years** in Wayne and Macomb County.

**Do you want to earn a minimum of \$75?**  
**Are you a parent or guardian of a child 5 years old or younger?**  
**Do you live in Wayne or Macomb Counties?**  
**Do you want to learn about resources available to you and your family?**

If you answered yes to all of these questions you may qualify to participate and earn a minimum of \$75. United Way for Southeastern Michigan is collaborating with community agencies, including Leaps and Bounds Family Services, to complete an evaluation study. This study will help us to understand how we can better serve families with young children. We are offering money to show appreciation for taking your time to participate.

**What Do I Have To Do?**

- Meet with staff in home or at our office
- Complete assessments about parenting skills, child development & family well-being
- Receive feedback on family strengths, areas for growth & connections to community resources

**Each time a set of assessments have been completed you will get \$25 cash. Assessments will be completed every 6 months for the duration of the study.**

**FREE** educational home visits are to focus on early learning and provide resources and activities to encourage child development. This program is for children from **birth to three years** in Wayne and Macomb County.
